



The 2nd National Symposium on English Language Assessment: Assessment for Learning 20-21 March 2019

The National Symposium on English Language Assessment is a language assessment initiative presented by the British Council Indonesia Foundation in collaboration with TEFLIN and Universitas Negeri Jakarta. The symposium provides a forum for assessment experts and practitioners, educational professionals and academics to interact, exchange information and keep abreast of the leading developments and issues in language assessment in Indonesia and wider Asia.

Following in the footsteps of the 1st National Symposium in 2018, the British Council Indonesia Foundation presents the 2nd National Symposium on English Language Assessment to be held in Jakarta on 20 - 21 March 2019. The focus is on the alignment of teaching and assessment in learning systems. The two-day event includes workshops, plenary sessions and panel discussions and smaller breakout group sessions.
